DVC's report: Academic Board 7th June 2017

1) General update (finances, admissions, recruitment)

- Applications/acceptances:
 - Applications (FT UG -17% on last year (-6% excl. Health)
 - Competitor group -10% (sector -4%)
 - Acceptances +2% on last year
 - Note that higher tariff retained
 - Health expects to hit target
- Finances
 - On target for £1.5M surplus in 2016-17 (target £1.0M)
 - March grant letter slightly better than expected
 - Income grown from £137M to £144M forecast
 - Contingencies mean that £3M surplus possible
 - Figures include £2.5M investment pots

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3) Family of Educational Providers

- Lambeth College
 - Plan is for it to become part of the LSBU Family
 - A number of issues still to address (e.g. governance, funding)
 - If it proceeds, current proposal is to locate a new College on the Vauxhall site, which is part of the Nine Elms development area
 - If it all goes ahead, likely to be complete early 2018
 - This is a separate educational provider within the LSBU 'group'
 - Some exciting progression opportunities, esp. w.r.t. apprenticeships
- •The South Bank Academy has been awarded 'Good' under all Ofsted categories
- •UTC opening new building this September, and has met its recruitment target

4) Inst. of Professional & Technical Education (IPTE)/Apprenticeships

- •Apprenticeship team of 6 in place (HEFCE funded); 120 apprentices, 400-500 by Oct. 2017
- •Reporting structure will include annual report to Academic Board (overview)
- •Passmore Library refurbishment (£5M funding from Southwark Borough Council) on target for opening in September 2018 (one-stop-shop, some teaching facilities, admin. base)

5) International

- New approval pathway for academic partnerships
- •Link tutor capacity for BUE (Egypt) developing, will transfer competences to ASU (Bahrain)
- •2nd current partnership closure review starting

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6) Research

- a) General
- •6th July Research Summer School poster competition and prizing
- •6th July launch of the London Doctoral Academy in London Road including:
 - o new student guide
 - supervision handbook
 - o code of practice
 - externally facing micro website
 - o training and development plan for students based on vitae rdf planner.
 - streamlined application, enrolment and induction process
 - o fully working student management system Haplo being rolled out
- •1st Annual University Research Audit completed and 1st investment plan designed
- •4 multidisc. institutes, 14 REF focussed centres and 34 'research for all' groups
- Professoriate and sabbaticals in development / running, respectively

- Meetings increased from 3 to 4 annually

c) Issues

- Compliance with publication repository statutory requirement
 - Summer action plan

- Induction of international centres, Egypt, Bahrain and potentially Dubai

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7) Education & Student Experience

- •DLHE results ... up again!
- •Progression rates have improved by 3% two years in a row; although current non-continuation in-year is similar to last year, good evidence that School Interns and Skills for Learning interventions have had a positive impact
- Shortlisted for THELMA award 'Outstanding Student Services Team'
- •Also strongly reflecting teaching drivers Guardian LT top 100!
- Awaiting TEF outcome, but well-placed to resubmit if 'bronze'
- •A staged strategy to develop DEL has been initiated, with initial funding and pilot proposals being supported ... more details in due course
- •Educational Framework, Academic Portfolio and Part-Time Issues on agenda
