Executive Summary

It is the recommendation of UUK that a student charter should form part of the student contract. The existing student charter had not been refreshed for a number of years and was largely unknown across the student and staff population.

In semester one 18/19, a project was launched to create a new student charter. It has been a collaborative effort between The Student's Union, academic staff and PSG staff. The working group members were keen that the charter have a distinct LSBU flavour, so it has drawn on existing strategies and there has been broad consultation.

The next stage is to socialise the charter with all members of the LSBU community and decide on a cycle of review and measurement.



Student Charter

London South Bank University is a community of students, academics, apprentices and professionals, working together to develop learning and research, to better the world around us.

Our charter seeks to guide the way we work together, both within LSBU, the community and wider world.

Contribution - We champion active participation in the life of our University. Our culture is vibrant and engaging. We value engagement in activities, in and out of the classroom. Contributing is vital to maximising our personal and collective successes.
