## Appointment of Jeremy Cope as Independent Governor

5. The committee considered the recommendation of the Chair Nomination Committee to appoint Jeremy Cope (paper AP.02(14)) as an Independent Governor of the University.
6. The Chair Nomination Committee had undertaken a thorough recruitment process and considered that Mr Cope had the necessary skills and experience.
7. The committee approved the appointment of Mr Cope as an Independent Governor for an initial term of four years to 31 July 2018 with immediate effect.
8. The appointment was made in the expectation that Mr Cope succeeds as Chairman of the Board on 1 August 2015, subject to approval by the Board as a whole at its meeting of 9 July 2015. If appointed Chairman he would commence a new term of four years.
9. Mr Cope will serve for the year to 31 July 2015 as a Joint Vice Chair of the Board and will become Chair of the Policy and Resources Committee at a suitable time. Mr Cope will be a member of the Property, Honorary Awards, Remuneration, and Nomination Committees.
