1. Welcome and apologies

Apologies were received from Ed Arthur.

2. **Declarations of interest**

There were no declarations of interest made in related to any item on the agenda.

3. **Risk presentation**

Governors heard that there was a new register for school risks and discussed the more-focussed entries that are now on the register.

Governors requested that retention of staff and student roll numbers be added to the risk register, either at trust or school level in order that these metrics be tracked.

Governors discussed the number and type of metrics used for evaluation of risk, especially in relation to Covid-19 and its impact on destinations and outcomes – this information will be used to promote the school and so it is important to monitor this information as less favourable metrics will increase the risk to the UTC.

4. **OFSTED Framework**

Governors agreed on the need to get back to doing school visits as soon as possible and for more information to be made available outside meetings in order to be able to triangulate information presented in school meetings.

Governors need to know what the school's values are too – students can rattle them off.

Governors noted the change in SEF format, step change to how it was done previously following Sarah Pashley's visit. Governors agreed the format is good, readable, easy to use and suggested a summary for governors be created.

Governors were keen that the work the school is doing with students who have been disenfranchised is highlighted clearly. The school continues to work on developing its structure to support these students.
